EU-US trade

The European Union and the United States have the largest bilateral trade and investment relationship and the most integrated economic relationship in the world.

Together, they represent almost **30% of global trade** in goods and services and **43% of global GDP**. In 2023, transatlantic trade in goods and services reached €1.6 trillion.

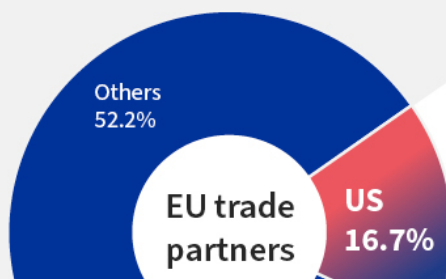

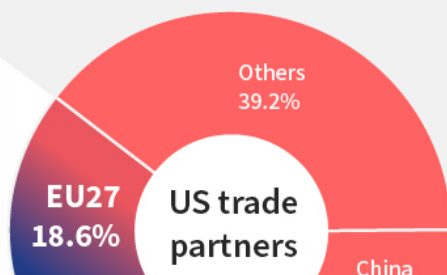

The EU's and US's main trade partners in goods

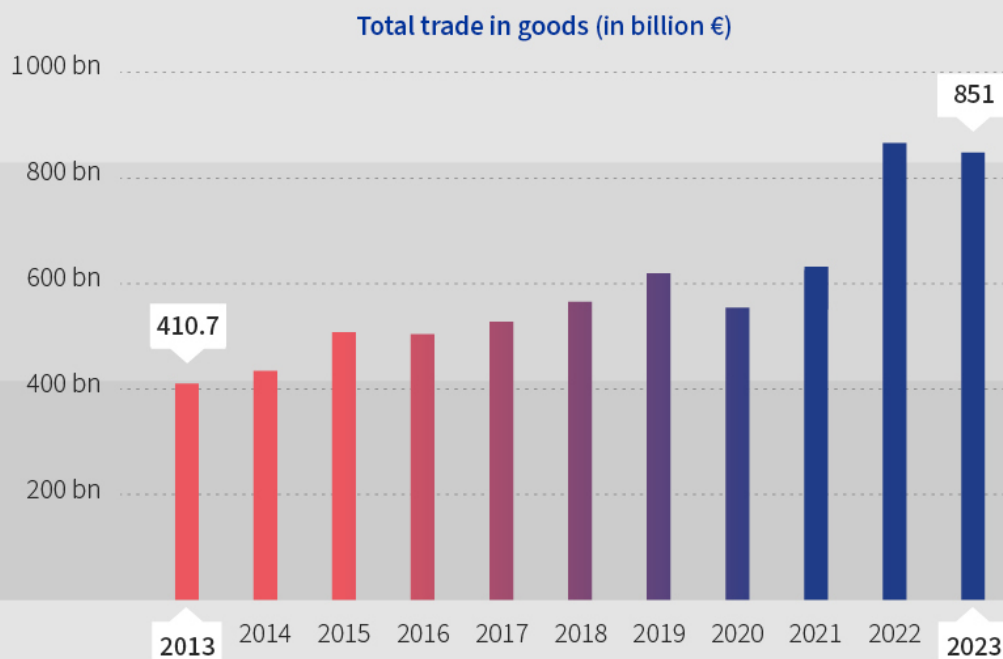

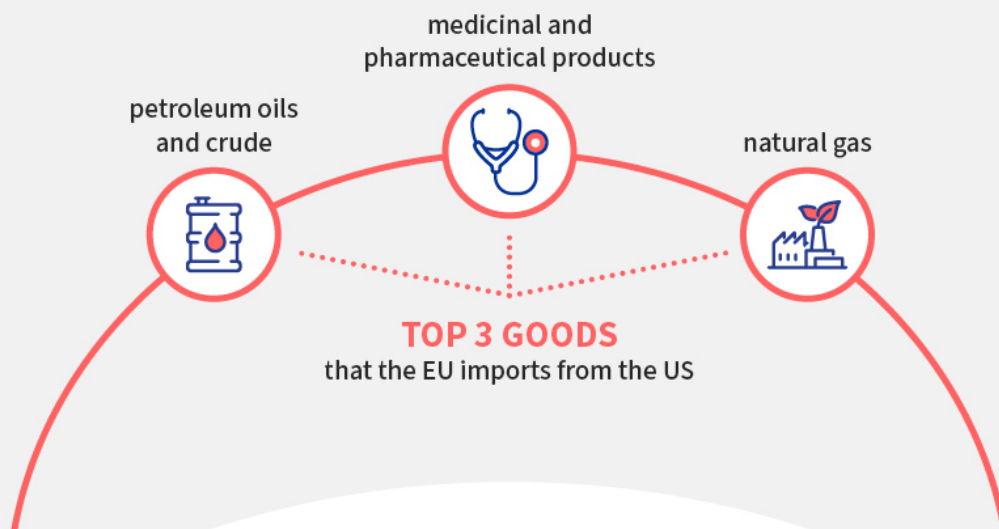


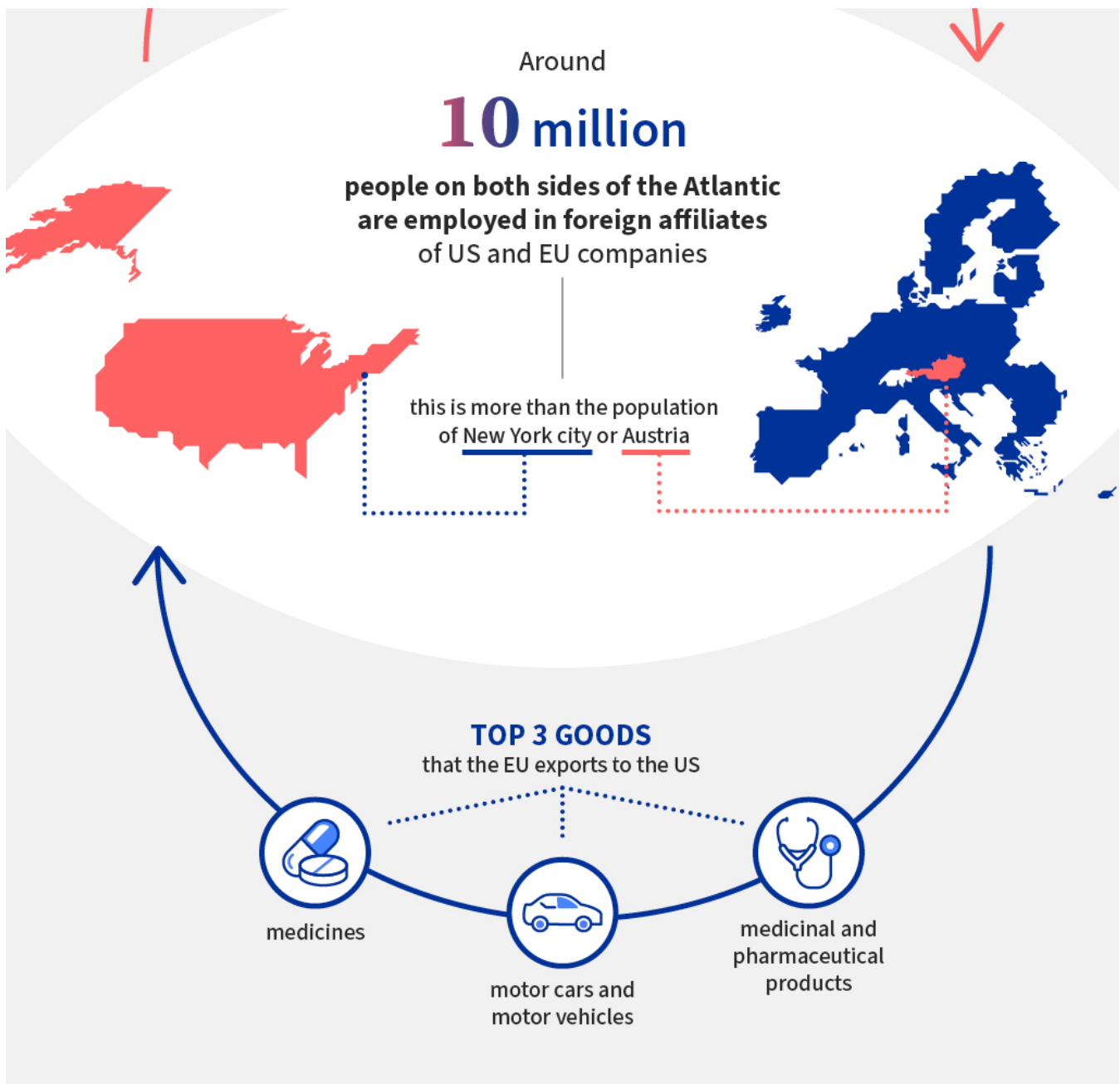


In the last decade, trade between the EU and the US has more than doubled.
